



Welcome to GILA!

Here are some tidbits to get you off to a great start!

- Remember that *YOU* are a part of the Ptarmigan Hall Community; please always show respect to your fellow community members and treat them as you'd like to be treated.
- Always check the white board in the lobby so you know what's happening every day.
- It's very important that you sign in and out at the front desk every time you come or go from Ptarmigan Hall; we need to know where our students are at all times.
- The door to your room will lock automatically when closed; make sure to always pull it closed tightly behind you, as certain items tend to occasionally grow legs and walk away. If you would prefer, you can borrow a lock from the front desk to help keep your valuables safe.
- If you get locked out of your room, an RA can key you in for .25.
- Laundry costs \$1 to wash and \$1 to dry. You can also buy soap at the front desk for \$1.
- If you lose your student ID, a replacement ID costs \$3.
- Please don't put tacks or staples in your walls; You can buy poster putty at the front desk for \$3 to decorate your room with. (Tacks & staples may only be used on your bulletin boards.)
- When listening to music in your room, it's important that it be at a volume just for your room so as not to disturb any of your neighbors.
- You are allowed to walk off campus in groups of two or more, as long as you each check out a reflective vest at the desk, and you stay within sight of the main roads of Galena. There is no cutting across the runway under any circumstances.
- You are allowed to get checked out by community members of the same gender; your parents need only complete the Check Out form, and have it approved by the Res. Hall Administrator.
- Your parents can also give you permission to ride ATVs & snow machines, or to go hunting.
- Every student will be expected to keep their room clean according to the chore checklist on the bathroom door. You may sign up for additional community chores, for which you can earn extra incentive pay.
- All students have the opportunity to earn level 3 status for maintaining their grades and doing community service. Once Level 3 status is attained, those students may have microwaves, TV's, & DVD players, as well as an extended evening curfew.
- Commitment is very important to us at GILA. If you sign up for an activity, you are expected to be there, on time for that activity. Same rule applies for any mandatory student meetings.
- There are 3 things you can do with that someone special: hug for 3 seconds, hold hands, & be *next to*, but not *on top of* each other.
